Overview

Part of the Scottish Wider Access Programme (SWAP) this course offers a unique learning experience to adults with few or no qualifications. If students complete the course successfully they can progress to higher education.

Entry Requirements

- There are no formal entry requirements for SWAP programmes. Students must be out of full-time education for 3 years or more, at the start of the course.
- Students who have previous qualifications at SCQF level 6 may also be eligible.
